- 1 Unique 2-pocket plastic folder <u>without</u> brads/prongs (Spanish No pop culture)
- 2/pack Sharpie black ultra fine tip markers "ART"

# Do Not Label These Items:

- 2 1½ inch 3 ring binder (any color but free of pop culture)
- 5 Tab binder dividers with pockets Multicolor
- 5 Sheet Protector Clear 8.5 x 11 inches (1 Per subject)
- 3 120 sheet packages of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper reinforced
- 1 2 pockets **yellow** plastic folders **without** brads/prongs
- 1 Plastic Protractor 6 Inches 180 Degrees (ruled on the bottom, keep at home until needed)
- 1 ruler (keep at home until needed for math)
- 3 reams white copy paper
