from 7:15-8:00 in the music room. They are encouraged to participate on Wednesday afternoons in addition to Friday morning rehearsals to not only improve their own abilities but also to mentor and lead younger and newer strings students.

The instrument shops will fit an instrument to your student so that it fits comfortably based on their height.
