### Label These Items:

- 1 Backpack – No rolling backpacks
- 1 Lunchbox
- 1 Reusable water bottle with sport top (No screw top bottles)
- 1 Personal ear buds for keyboarding instruction (in a bag)
- 1 Pointed student sized scissors
- 1 Pencil bag – a soft bag that can lay flat, no hard cases
- 4 2-pocket plastic folders with or without brads/prongs -Please label these at home as follows: Red (Language Arts), Blue (History), Green (Science); Purple (Math)
- 1 2 pocket plastic folder **Yellow** with brads/prongs (Take Home Folder)
- 3 100 page wide-ruled **UN-perforated** spiral notebooks. Please label these at home as follows: **Red** (Language Arts); **Green** (Science); **Purple** (Math)
- 1 Composition Notebook (labeled with **scholar name** and "**Roots Journal and Book Reading Log**")
- 1 Ruler
- 1 Plastic protractor 6 inches 180 degrees
- 2 100 sheet packages of Wide Ruled filler paper
- 1 12 pack colored pencils
- 1 Orange 2 pocket plastic folder without brads/prongs (Spanish )

- 5 12 pack, #2, 6-sided wooden pencils, sharpened (Ticonderoga brand only)
- 30 Sharpened red erasable wooden pencils
- 20 Avery or Scotch brand permanent glue sticks
- 2 4 pack Expo low odor dry-erase markers (black only)
- 1 8 pack washable Crayola broad tip or fine tip markers (classic colors)
- 1 6 pack of highlighters
- 2 Packages of 3" x 5" lined index cards
- 1 12 pack eraser caps **LATEX FREE**
